

Privacy Policy

Effective: July, 2026

This Privacy Policy (“Policy”) includes important information about your personal data and we encourage you to read it carefully. This Policy applies when you use our Safe Cleaner: Secure & Private (“App” or “Service”) and describes the personal data that we collect, how we use and share it, and how you can reach us with privacy-related inquiries. The Policy also outlines your rights and choices as a data subject. In this Policy, “we”, “us”, or “our” refers to STRUCTA LIMITED.

● Data We Collect

When you use our App, we will collect your information such as:
your name and email address.

- (1) IP addresses.
- (2) usage data includes the pages of our App you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers another diagnostic data.
- (3) device information includes device types and settings, device identifiers (such as IDFA, IDFV for Android, GAID for IOS), browser types, mobile, wireless, operating system versions, another network information (such as internet service provider name, carrier name and signal strength), and application version numbers.
- (4) activity Information directly related to your use of the App, includes contact list and or photos.

● How We Use Your Data

We may use your personal data to the following purposes:

- (1) provide the Services to you.
- (2) conduct research and development for our Services in order to provide you and others with a better, more intuitive and personalized experience.

- (3) contact you to inform the availability of our Services, security, or other service-related issues.
- (4) investigate, respond to and resolve complaints and for Service issues.
- (5) security purposes or to prevent or investigate possible fraud or other violations of the law, our Terms.

- Sharing of Personal Data

We share personal data in the ways listed below:

- (1) with other affiliated entities for purposes identified in this Policy.
- (2) service providers authorized by us to use or disclose the personal data we make available to them to perform services on our behalf and to comply with relevant legal obligations.
- (3) when we believe it is necessary to comply with applicable law; to secure and protect the Services, rights, privacy, safety, and property of you and us; and to respond to valid legal requests from courts, law enforcement agencies, regulatory agencies, and other public and government authorities.

- Minors

Our Services are not directed to children under the age of 13, and we request that they do not provide personal data to seek Services directly from us. In certain jurisdictions, we may impose other age limits as required by applicable law.

- Data Retention

We retain your personal data for as long as we continue to provide the Services to you, or for a period in which we reasonably foresee continuing to provide the Services. Even after we stop providing Services directly to you, we may continue to retain your personal data to:

- (1) Enable fraud monitoring, detection, and prevention activities.
- (2) Comply with our legal and regulatory obligations.

- Security

We implement security safeguards designed to protect your data. We regularly monitor our systems for possible vulnerabilities and attacks. We maintain organizational, technical, and administrative measures designed to protect the personal data covered by this Policy from unauthorized access, destruction, loss, alteration, or misuse.

- Your Data Protection Rights and Choices

Depending on your location and subject to applicable law, you may have the following rights regarding the personal data we process about you:

- (1) The right to request confirmation of whether we are processing personal data associated with you, the categories of personal data it has processed, and the third parties or categories of third parties with which your personal data is shared;
- (2) The right to request access to the personal data we process about you;
- (3) The right to request that we rectify or update your personal data if it's inaccurate, incomplete, or outdated;
- (4) The right to request that we erase your personal data in certain circumstances as provided by law;
- (5) The right to withdraw your consent if your personal data is being processed based on your previous consent.

Please remember that when you use a link to go from the Service to another website, our Policy does not apply to third-party websites or services.
